Mobile Manufacturing Crew (MMC): Community based manufacturing prevocational skill building services provided at local manufacturing partners' facilities

- MMC has maintained 3 active contracts; DieTech Tool & Manufacturing, Unlimited Quality Sorting & Assembly, and C Distribution

Retail Training (RT): Affords trainees the opportunity to explore and gain employment skills related to retail environments through the agency owned consignment store, New To You Consignment.

TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOR, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Specifically, Title VI provides that "no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance" (42 U.S.C. Section 2000d).
